This is the second of three increments discussing this year's SAME National Goals. The goals are very important to this post because we must attempt to meet them to be eligible for streamer awards and the recognition those streamers bring.

Goal 2 is to Engage in solutions through Growth. Growth meaning growth of our post through increased and more diverse membership, as well as growth of the individuals in the post through engineering and professional development and personal mentoring.

The growth of our post begins with a Post staying engaged by recruiting and tailoring Post Outreach Programs to reach underrepresented groups. The post executive committee needs your help to put on attractive programs to membership. The recruiting goal is to:

- Increase young members (under 36 yrs of age) by **5%**.
- Increase **individual memberships** in all categories.
- Increase **corporate and public agency Sustaining Members.**
- Show a cumulative total increase in all membership categories of **2 % by the end of CY03.**

Programs should be tailored to promote engineering and professional development. Posts should:

- Conduct at least six events that promote educational development and provide CEUs or PDHs.
- Conduct at least two activities that provide professional licensure/registration assistance to young members.

- *Develop at least two professional training programs (with PDH credits).*

Posts should sponsor mentoring opportunities to facilitate leadership growth opportunities for young military, professional and student affiliates.

Mentoring goals include:

- *Establishing and conducting a formal mentor-protégé program for Young Members, led by Fellows, in your Post*
- *Helping establish the next generation of engineers by leading/sponsoring at least two interactive events with a local high or middle school (i.e. the DA eCyberMission program, MathCounts, Outreach Programs).*

As I stated above, we need your help to achieve these goals. Our program chairs have a diverse and attractive program planned but could use everyone's help to put together the individual events. If your schedule does not allow you to volunteer to put together an event, help by attending the events and bringing co-workers to participate and learn about SAME. 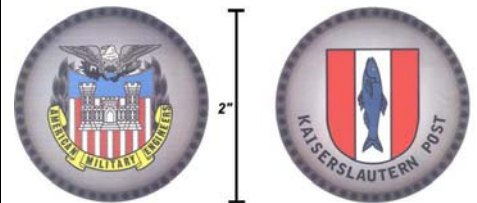
