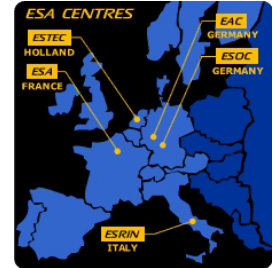
EUROPEAN SPACE OPERATIONS CENTRE
